- Carnivore feeding tour with ambassador animals.


## ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

This half-day Carnivore Feeding tour at N/a'ankuse Wildlife Sanctuary includes the opportunity to see baboons, caracals, lions, cheetahs, wild dogs, and leopards. This half-day tour allows you to watch as the animals are being fed by the experienced guides as well as a chance to get some spectacular photos of these majestic animals. It is followed by a scenic drive that provides a good chance of spotting some of the other wildlife on the reserve. This is not just a great way to learn about these amazing animals and how they behave in the wild, but it is also a great up-close photo opportunity.
