Next, set off for the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and the Cape Point lighthouse, a popular stop for photographs. Continue to Simon's Town to see the monument of the Great Dane dog who made his own history in the South African Navy. Visit Boulder's Beach and see the penguin colony. Guest will be back afternoon before dinner. There are variety places for guest to choose to go have their lunch and dinner.
