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ITINERARY (DAY BY DAY):

DAY 1: WINDHOEK

Accommodation: Arebbusch Travel Lodge / Similar

Guest will be picked up at the airport and dropped at their accommodation in Windhoek and will be picked up by the tour guide after lunch to go on a Windhoek City tour. Situated in Central Namibia, the cosmopolitan city of Windhoek serves as the capital of the country. It is home to an international airport and a plethora of restaurants, shops, entertainment venues and accommodation options. The city is clean, safe and well-organised, with a colonial legacy that is reflected in its many German eateries and shops, and the widespread use of the German language. After the activity there are other optional activities that can be.

Overnight: Arebbusch Travel Lodge

Arebbusch Travel Lodge offers high quality accommodation at affordable rates in a natural setting in Windhoek – a gateway to the many wonders of Namibia's beautiful wide open spaces, its fascinating variety of cultures, nature, wildlife and majestic sunsets. Situated on the banks of the dry Arebbusch River, Arebbusch Travel Lodge nestles in the natural surroundings of the "veld". DAY 2- WINDHOEK TO SOSSUSVLEI (392.7.KM)

Accommodation: Desert Camp, Sesriem or Similar

Guest will drive after breakfast at 09:00-09:30 and departs to Sossusvlei area. Along the way clients will stop at Rehoboth where the guide will buy snacks for 45minutes and this is an opportunity for guest to get some snacks and drinks for the road.

Guest can lunch at 12h00-13h00 along the road by a rest place. After arrival guest will have leisure time before going on a Sundowner drive to dune around 17h30 or 18h00.

Meals: Dinner

Included Activity: Sundowner at Dunes



DAY 3 – SOSSUVLEI / SESRIEM AREA

Accommodation: Desert Camp, Sesriem or Similar

Guest will wake up and have breakfast before going into the park for Sossuvlei Excursion which includes Dune 45, Deadvlei, Hiddenvlei, and Big Daddy. The tour guide will have regular stops to let clients take pictures and have some exposure of the Dunes. Guest will be back around lunch time and will have some leisure time for themselves at the pool.

Overnight: Desert Camp

Self-catering at its Best amidst unparalleled Desert Beauty...

Desert Camp is situated just 5 km from the entrance gate to Sossusvlei and Sesriem Canyon in the Namib Naukluft Park. Nestled under centuries old camel thorn trees, Desert Camp offers unsurpassed views over the Desert landscapes and surrounding mountains – An absolute must for the nature lover and photographer!

The 28 affordable self-catering accommodation units are equipped with an en-suite bathroom, shaded veranda with a fitted kitchenette, barbeque, power points and an adjacent parking area. Each air-conditioned room features twin beds and a fold-out sleeper couch to accommodate 2 small children (under 12) free of charge when sharing with 2 full paying adults. Utility boxes with most utensils needed are available at reception and fresh food supplies can be ordered daily.

Facilities at the main building include a fully stocked and serviced bar with big screen television, a sparkling swimming pool and 2 communal bomas with cooking and wash up facilities which are perfect for groups travelling together.

Meals can be enjoyed at the nearby Sossusvlei Lodge restaurant and their Adventure Centre offers a range of exciting Desert activities to explore the area.

A fully stocked shop, fuel and an Internet café is available at the Sossus Oasis Service Station.



DAY 4: SOSSUSVLEI TO SWAKOPMUND (402.6KM)

Accommodation: Orange House, Swakopmund / Similar

Guest will eat breakfast and depart to Swakopmund early around 09:00 along the beautiful landscape to the coastal side of Namibia. It's about 5 hours' drive to Swakopmund. Once clients have arrived in Walvis Bay and can get lunch then visit the Lagoons in Walvis before proceeding to Swakopmund, When Clients arrive in Swakopmund they will go for their activity (Quad biking). After the activity Other optional activities can be done like Skydiving, Sandwich harbour, kayaking, desert tour.

DAY 5: SWAKOPMUND AREA

Accommodation: Orange House, Swakopmund / Similar

Guest will get early Breakfast and then visit to the Museum and from there onwards do a City Tour. This day guest will have leisure time to relax at the beach or walk around in town.

Included Activity: Museum and City Tour

Overnight: Orange House

DAY 6- SWAKOPMUND TO DAMARALAND (199.5 KM)

Accommodation: Ugab Terrace Lodge, Damaraland or similar

Clients will depart in the morning to Damaraland which is the vast desert landscape is known as one of the most beautiful regions in Namibia. Huge, untamed and ruggedly beautiful, Damaraland is an exceptionally scenic landscape featuring open plains, ancient valleys and spectacular rock formations. The major attractions are the sacred Spitzkoppe, the Brandberg, Twyfelfontein, Vingerklip and the otherworldly Petrified Forest. Visitors can take in the dramatic vistas, catch a glimpse of the rare desert-adapted elephant, and enjoy spectacular stargazing in crystal-clear night skies from one of the many safari camps dotting Damaraland.

DAY 7: DAMARALAND AREA

Accommodation: Ugab Terrace Lodge, Damaraland or similar

Clients will have morning breakfast and go on a game drive whereby they will be back around lunch and after lunch have some free time to rest.

DAY 8: DAMARALAND TO PALMWAG (234.0 KM)

Accommodation: Palmwag Lodge Gondwana Collection Namibia, Palmwag Similar

This morning guests will freshen and depart after breakfast in the morning to Palmwag. Palmwag is a nature reserve idyllically located along a palm-lined tributary of the Uniab River. Water is scarce in this area, so the river's presence often lures elephants closer to the camps. Palmwag is situated halfway between Swakopmund and Etosha and is the ideal base from which to see the sights of the Kunene region or embark on one of the many local hiking trails. Upon arrival clients will go for game drive.

DAY 9: DAMARALAND TO PALMWAG (234.0 KM)

Accommodation: Palmwag Lodge Gondwana Collection Namibia, Palmwag Similar

Guest will have nice breakfast and go on early game drive; this day guest will have leisure time to explore the place and before dinner go on a guided walk. Animal lovers can also get a peek at leopard, lion, cheetah, mountain zebra, Angolan giraffe, springbok, kudu, and African bush elephant.

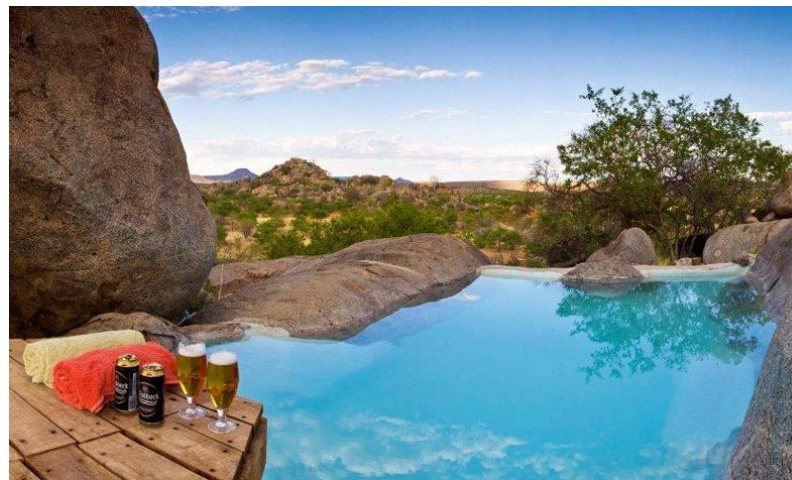

Guest will depart today after a fresh shower to Etosha and on arrival clients will get lunch and after Lunch, if time permits, enter Etosha for an afternoon game drive. Depending on how often you stop today, On entering the park, the first stop would be Okaukuejo where you pay your entry fee and I suggest you pop in at the local shop to purchase some drinks and snacks and most importantly, a map of Etosha which will show you all the waterholes along the way. Etosha has lions, giraffes, rhinos, zebras, springbok and elephants. This on top of many lesser and common plains herds, and abundant birds makes game viewing in Etosha.

DAY 10: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK AREA

Accommodation: Taleni Etosha Village, Etosha South /Similar

This morning guest will have breakfast and go on the full day game drive inside the park, as they are on the drive the guide will have a stop at Halali around 12h00-13h00 for lunch and after lunch go on their game drive journey until afternoon.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Overnight: Taleni Etosha Village

DAY 11- ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK, ETOSHA VILLAGE TO HALALI (90.4 KM)

Accommodation: Halali Resort, Etosha National Park or similar

Guest will have breakfast go on a full game drive inside the park where they will overnight at Halali. including a variety of large mammals such as lion, elephant, leopard, rhino, zebra, giraffe, a diversity of birdlife such as flamingoes and pelicans.

Meals included: Dinner

Activities Included: Afternoon Game Drive

Overnight: Halali Resort

Strategically located halfway between Okaukuejo and Namutoni, Halali is situated at the base of a dolomite hill, amongst shady Mopane trees. A flood-lit waterhole which is viewed from an elevated vantage point provides exceptional wildlife viewing throughout the day and into the night. Accommodation is provided in family chalets, two and four bed bush chalets and double rooms – all converted with large sliding doors to the outside, to allow visitors to experience and benefit from the peace and tranquility of the natural surroundings. Other facilities include a restaurant, bar, shop, swimming pool, kiosk and camping facilities.



DAY 12- ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK, HALALI TO NAMUTONI (69.8 KM)

Accommodation: Namutoni Resort, Etosha East or similar

Guest will grab a nice breakfast and as they are driving on game viewing to Namutoni, guest will arrive around lunch and after lunch have leisure time to relax around the pool at the lodge.

Meals included: Dinner

Activities Included: Morning Game Drive

Overnight: Namutoni Resort

The lodge centres on an old German Fort overlooking the King Nehale waterhole; an elevated decked walkway provides excellent opportunities for enjoying the surrounding scenery, wildlife and the spectacular sunsets. The Fort has been developed into a hub of activity, offering two restaurants, a relaxation lounge, a bar, crafts boutique, curio shop, jewellers and bookstore. Accommodation is provided in comfortable double rooms or bush chalets. Camping is also available.



DAY 13- NAMUTONI ETOSHA TO GROOTFONTEIN

Accommodation: Roy's Rest Camp, Grootfontein or similar

Clients will have morning breakfast and drive to Grootfontein, unlike many destinations in Namibia, Grootfontein is extremely lush and fertile and in the summer months, purple Jacaranda trees create a riot of colour around the town. Upon arrival guest will visit the Hoba meteorite, one of the largest ever discovered on earth, located roughly 25 kilometres from the town centre

Meals included: Breakfast and Dinner

Activities Included: Visit Meteorite

Overnight: Roy's Rest Camp

Roy's Rest Camp is a small part of the farm Elandsplaagte. The camp was started in 1995 and was built for cattle farming and tourism as the main industries. Elandsplaagte is one of the older farms in the district of Grootfontein, and has been in operation since 1930. Roy's Camp is situated on the main road from Grootfontein to Rundu, 55 km north of Grootfontein. It is an ideal stopover from northern Namibia to Caprivi and bushman land. There are 5 standard rooms and 2 family rooms all with en suite facilities and private braai areas. The camp bungalows are of a unique rustic design. All rooms have air conditioning and mosquito nets. There are also 16 campsites with braai facilities and hot water.



DAY 14: GROOTFONTEIN TO OKAVANGO RIVER

Accommodation: Shametu River Lodge, Okavango River / Similar

Guests will get early morning Breakfast and drive to The Okavango River is the fourth-largest river system in southern Africa. Starting in Angola, it runs southeastward into Namibia and forms part of the Angolan/Namibian border. Visitors can soak up the magnificent views of the cascading Popa Falls, a popular tourist attraction, just before the river crosses over into Botswana creating the renowned Okavango Delta. The area surrounding the river is known for its lush vegetation, spectacular natural beauty, and abundant wildlife.

Included Activity: Mokoro Trip

Overnight: Shametu River Lodge

Shametu River Lodge enjoys luxurious solitude on the edge of the Okavango river with a magnificent view of the unique Popa Falls. The lodge is halfway between the major gems of Southern Africa, the Okavango Delta and the Victoria Falls, making it an ideal stopover to unwind during your journey. However it should not only be seen as a stopover, Shametu River Lodge is in a close proximity of a few of Namibia's untamed National Parks the Buffalo core area inside the Bwabwata National Park and Mahangu National park.

We will be offering affordable Chalets and Tented chalets with breathtaking views of the unspoilt Okavango river and the thundering Popa Falls. A true African experience! There are 4 luxury chalets, 4 luxury tented chalets and 7 standard chalets. All units have electricity, hot water showers and Wifi.

Shametu River Lodge is already known for their "five star" camping experience with green grass and shaded trees. There are eight campsites each with their own ablution blocks offering hot water, kitchenette, wifi and electricity facilities.



DAY 15: OKAVANGO RIVER TO OKAVANGO DELTA 644 KM

Accommodation: Audi Camp fully equipped Tented rooms, Okavango Delta / Similar

Guests will grab a nice breakfast in the morning and then drive to Okavango Delta. Situated in the north-western corner of Botswana, the Okavango Delta is a World Heritage Site as it is the largest inland delta in the world. The magnificent Okavango River sprawls out over the dry sands of the Kalahari Desert forming this flourishing waterlogged oasis featuring countless meandering waterways and crystal-clear lagoons studded with water lilies, as well as fertile floodplains and reeded islands inhabited with abundant wildlife.

After checking in and freshening up In the Afternoon the guest will have leisure time around the lodge.

DAY 16: OKAVANGO DELTA AREA

Accommodation: Audi Camp fully equipped Tented rooms, Okavango Delta / Similar

Clients will grab early Breakfast and then go on a Full Day Okavango Excursion the game drive. And will be back in the afternoon.

Overnight: Audi Camp

Audi Camp is situated at the edge of the Okavango Delta 12 km away from Maun, on the road toward the Moremi Game Reserve. It is located on the banks of the Thamalakane river, the southernmost tributary of the Okavango Delta. Audi Camp offers camping, tented accommodation and en suite tents. The camp has an a la carte restaurant, a bar and pool and can also cater for a wide variety of activities in and around the Okavango Delta including, cultural and community-based trips.



DAY 17: OKAVANGO DELTA TO MAUN 65.8 KM

Accommodation: Maun Lodge, Maun / Similar

Guests will grab early Breakfast and then take a short drive to Maun Lodge situated in Maun. Maun is set on the banks of the beautiful Thamalakane River in northern Botswana, Maun is the third largest town in this spectacularly scenic southern African country. Maun is the starting point for most expeditions into the Okavango Delta and as a result, has developed into a bustling metropolis that is considered Botswana's tourism capital. After checking in and freshening up In the Afternoon the clients will depart for a Mokoro Excursion (for 2 hours) After this activity clients will get back and the lodge and get ready for Dinner.

Included Activities: Mokoro Excursion with canoe

DAY 18: MAUN TO CHOBE RIVER FRONT (609.6 KM)

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge, Chobe River Front / Similar

Clients will have a game drive throughout Chobe and its beautiful landscape across the challenging Magwike Sand point, which was the shoreline of the ancient inland sea, visit the Makgadikgadi Lake. Its deep sand, so in the wet season, it becomes impassable. After arrival clients will check in and prepare for dinner.

DAY 19: CHOBE RIVER FRONT

Accommodation: Chobe Safari Lodge, Chobe River Front / Similar

Today Guest will have breakfast and have leisure time to relax around the lodge.
